**Indian Army Day 2022:** India celebrates Army Day with tremendous zeal on January 15. It commemorates Field Marshal Koonjerat M. Cariappa (15. 18. 1894), who had been the Commander-in-Chief of the Indian Army. Every year, the day is marked by conducting a military parade and many other martial displays at Delhi Cantonment's Carapaga Parade Ground.

We will mark the 74th Indian Army Day with almost the same pride, zeal and passion in 2022 as that our coming generations can understand the sacrifices and contributions made by the Indian Army.

While celebrations take place across the country, the main **Army Day** parade is conducted in Carapaga Parade ground's Delhi Cantonment. Carapaga awards and Sansa medals are also awarded on this day. In 2020, 15 soldiers were presented with Sansa medals. Sansa Ve Chakra and Sansa Chakra awards participate in the Army Day parade every year. Military hardware, exercises contingents and a combat display are part of the parade in 2020. Captain **Tania Shargil** became the first female officer to command an Army Day parade.

**HOW INDIAN ARMY DAY IS OBSERVED IN THE COUNTRY?**

Because they are determined to become a war-fighting force, the Indian Army plays a key role during crises. This day was recognized as Indian Army Day to start paying respect to the martyred Indian army personnel at the "Army Avenue Jant" at New Delhi's India Gate.

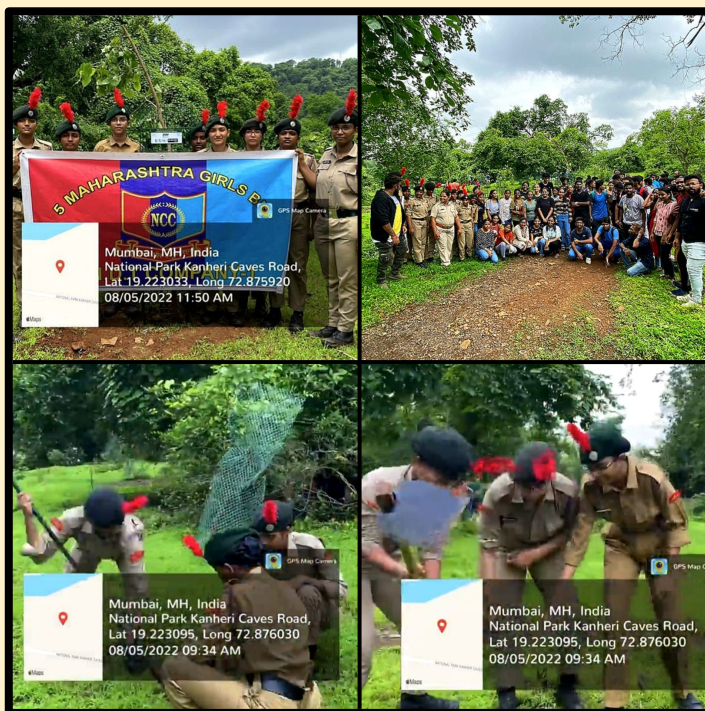

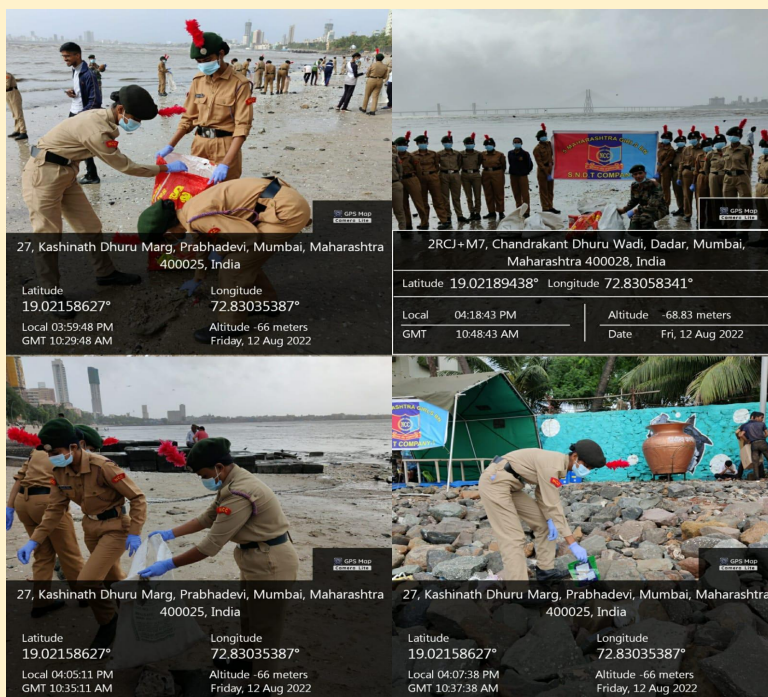

# UNITY RUN

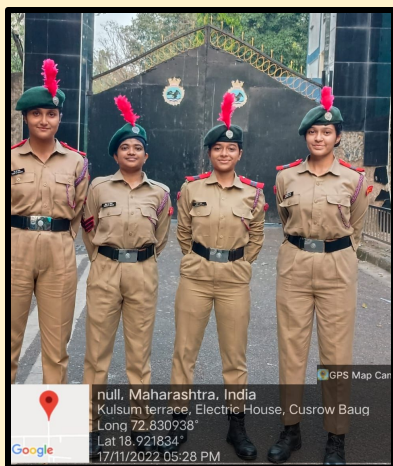

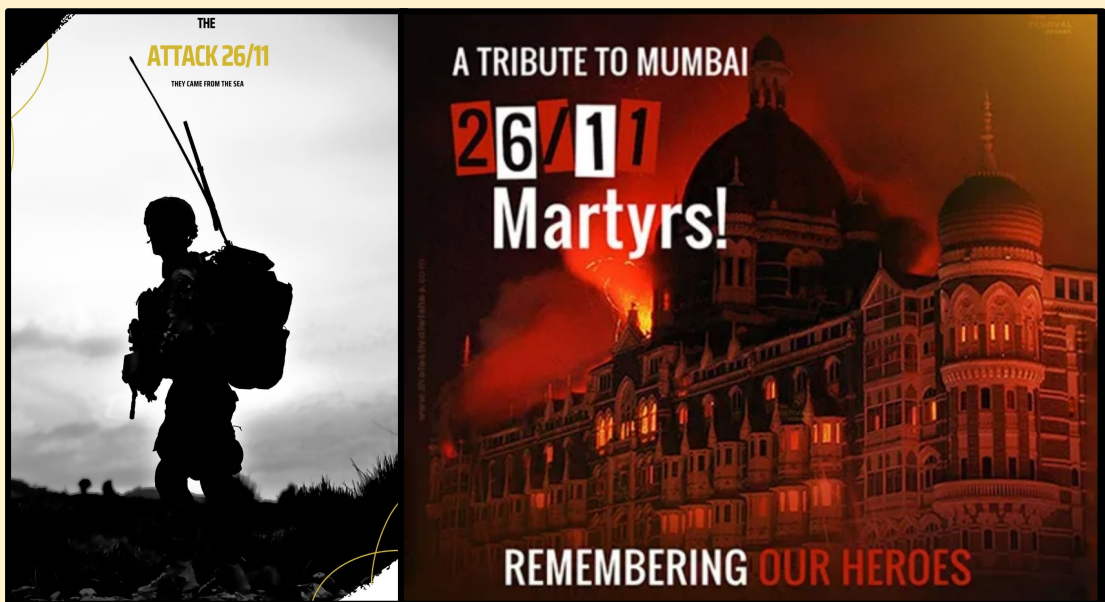
